> REQUIREMENTS FOR BUSINESS

Requirements for your workplace and the actions you will put in place to keep your customers and workers safe

REQUIREMENTS	ACTIONS
<i>Schedule 1, Column 1, No 13 Information and education facilities</i>	<i>No of persons calculated by allowing 4 sq m of space per person</i>
If you are unwell	Staff or guests who are unwell are not to be on the premises
Warmth and safety outdoors	No blankets, sleeping bags, beanies, gloves or scarves will be issued. Guests must plan to wear six or more layers of clothing and bring own blankets and personal warm gear
Transportation services	Not offered by Outback Astronomy
Audio units	None to be loaned out. All guests must bring their own ear phones or headsets, or buy a set from Outback Astronomy. Audio units disinfected after each use.
Chairs	Chairs used in sky shows will be rotated.

	Chairs will be UV disinfected after use.
Sky dome capacity	The sky dome has ample capacity to allow 4 sq m of space to guests. Outback Astronomy is limiting attendance at sky shows to suit the event and the conditions. Sky show capacity may range from 4 persons to 50 persons.
Distancing 4 sq m per person	Sky show chairs will be spaced enabling 4 sq m per person. Different booking groups of unconnected persons will be spaced further apart.
Distancing of guests upon arrival, entry to building, and exit	<p>Depending on sky show bookings, the type of event and weather conditions:</p> <p>Guests may be given staggered arrival and departure instructions.</p> <p>Gatherings of persons outside and inside the building will be minimised.</p> <p>Gatherings of persons inside the building will be controlled by signage and markers.</p> <p>Guests must follow directions of staff at the venue.</p> <p>Guests may be required to wait at the sky dome for other guests to arrive (and not wait inside the building).</p> <p>At conclusion of the event, guests may be required to exit the venue in staggered groups.</p>
Optical equipment	Binoculars and telescope equipment is disinfected after use.
Guest hand hygiene	<p>Guests are encouraged to use hand sanitiser.</p> <p>Outback Astronomy will supply soap and sanitiser on the premises.</p>
Food service outdoors, under the stars	Sky Dom Café COVID-19 Plan followed.
Venue hygiene, cleaning	Sky Dom Café COVID-19 Plan followed.
